2. What do we do at Mass?*
Listen to the faith of children and witness the importance of liturgy in the formation of a Christian
Grades 3 and up. 17 minutes
3. Why do we go to Mass on Sunday?*
In this video, children discover that just as we need to gather regularly as a family at home to listen to one another and celebrate who we are, so must we come together as a parish family to listen to God's Word and break bread in memory of Jesus
Grades 2 and up. 13 minutes
4. Mass for older Children*
This video walks students through the Mass and challenges them to live it in their daily lives
Grade 4 and up. 15 minutes
5. Close encounters with the Mass *
Real-life situations are combined with fantasy and humor to show young people that the Mass is relevant and meaningful to them. Important items like the altar, tabernacle and ambo are explained so youngsters will see the celebration in a whole new way!
Grades 2 and up. 13 minutes
6. Childhood of Jesus; Ministry of John the Baptist *
This video is a walk through the New Testament.

Ages 3 and up. 30 minutes
22. Where's God When I'm Scared?—Veggie Tales: Tales from the Crisper -
Junior learns that God is bigger than anything he might be afraid of.
Daniel and the Lion's Den – Kids will learn that they are always in God's hand.
Ages 3-8. 30 minutes
23. Close encounters with the Beatitudes *
Young Jimmy is puzzled as to what the Beatitudes mean to someone his age, but during the duration of the video, he comes to an understanding and makes a commitment to live the Beatitudes in his own life!

This video helps children learn how to resist peer pressure and stand up for what they believe in.

39. Esther

What would you do if your uncle asked you to risk your life to save the lives of your countrymen? This is a story of faithfulness to God. Watch and listen as Esther's courage and wisdom help her to turn a horrible tragedy into a joyous occasion of victory and celebration.

All ages. 30 minutes

40. Elisha

As chariots swooped down from heaven to snatch away the great prophet Elijah, his mantle fell to the ground and landed on his frightened protégé-Elisha. From now on, Elisha would be God's mouthpiece. The video highlights Elisha's healing of a soldier's disease to his restoring life to a young boy.

All ages. 30 minutes

41. God wants me to forgive them?—Veggie Tales

- The Grapes of Wrath...What do you get when a bunch of very cranky grapes make fun of five year-old Junior Asparagus? One sad asparagus and one big problem! Can Junior's dad show the grapes the error of their ways? Will Junior ever be able to forgive them?
- Larry's Lagoon...A 3 hour boat ride takes a turn for the worse when first mate Larry absentmindedly crashes into an uncharted tropical island! Can Skipper Bob and the passengers possibly forgive Larry for making such a huge blunder? While the professor discovers how many contraptions can be built out of bamboo and coconuts, the others discover the real reasons God wants us to forgive.

The ground was still and hushed as the words of the great prophet Elijah thundered down from Mount Carmel: How long will you go back and forth between two options? If the Lord be God, follow Him! If Baal be god, then follow him and be done with it! This video relives those fateful days when the faith of ancient Israel hung in the balance and challenges us to consider our faith as well.

Archibald has cancelled “Silly Songs with Larry” yet the viewer will be pulled into singing some of their favorite Veggie Tale songs.

56. Baptism: A Sacrament of Belonging

Alfredo, a young Mexican boy orphaned by a tragic fire wanders the villages of Mexico in search of acceptance and family. He is badly scarred both physically and emotionally by the fire that robbed him of his family. Alfredo comes upon an orphanage whereby the priest and the other children already in the orphanage help with his healing and wholeness in the family of God.

Grades 4 and up. 15 minutes

57. Reconciliation *

As God’s family, the church, we help one another in peace, love and friendship and continue God’s work of forgiveness. When we fail to live this way, our sin affects everyone around us and the world as well. Reconciliation is the sacrament that helps us heal our relationship with God, ourselves and others when we sin.

61. Jesus: What He Said, What He Did

Viewers will see Jesus’ Baptism, Jesus teaching in parables, Jesus performing miracles, the Crucifixion and Resurrection. 2-D animation For ages 3 to 7. 22 minutes

63. The Mouse in the Manager

Oscar, the mouse, becomes angry with his father and leaves home. His is lonely as he travels he meets Martha the cow, Hank the sheep and Sidney the donkey. He learns about himself and returns home with a better understanding of himself and those around him. Ages 3 and up. 20 minutes

65. The Easter Story (Hanna– Barbera) (2 copies)
Seen through the eyes of the Apostle Mark, it begins with Jesus' joyful entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. It continues with Christ's betrayal, arrest and crucifixion and His triumphant Resurrection and Ascension into heaven. All ages. 30 minutes
- 66 Moses - (The Greatest Adventure series)
Moses goes to Pharaoh and demands the Israelites must be set free. After Pharaoh's refusal destructive plagues are sent down upon Egypt, the Israelites are eventually freed, but Pharaoh changes his mind and pursues them to the Red Sea. All ages. 30 min

81. Are You My Neighbor?—Veggie Tales
The first story is the story of the Good Samaritan and that loving your neighbor means more than those who live next door. In the Gourds must be Crazy, loving your neighbor means appreciating those who are different, instead of making fun of them!
All ages. 15 minutes each segment
82. Esther –Veggie Tales
The king needs a new queen. Esther is chosen and finds out it takes more courage than she ever imagined! Kids learn never to be afraid of doing what is right. All ages. 25 minutes

83. The Ballad of Little Joe—Veggie Tales

This is the story of Joseph and his coat of many colors, told as a Western! Viewers learn to keep the faith in hardships because God can work all things out! All ages. 35 minutes

84. King George and the Ducky—Veggie Tales

King George spent most of his time in the bathtub because that is where he played with his favorite toy – his rubber ducky! But one ducky wasn't enough for George, he wanted all the rubber duckies! He decides that he is the most important person of all! Can he learn to put others first before it is too late? All Ages. 20 minutes

What IS the silliest song of all times? All ages. 50 minutes

86. Josh and the Big Wall—Veggie Tales

After 40 years of wandering in the desert, the children of Israel finally get to the Promised Land. But they overlooked Jericho! Should they do things their way or God's way? All ages. 30 minutes

87. The Toy That Saved Christmas—Veggie Tales
